Here are some ways that Every Student Sent can help in the areas that you may already be passionate about:

CHRISTIAN LIFE

- **Evangelism** – we train and equip students to be more successful than they ever have been – as [new college freshmen](#)

CHURCHES & FAMILIES

- **[Churches page](#)** – including separate national pages for [Assemblies of God](#) and [Southern Baptist](#) Equip leaders and parents to preserve and prepare the next generation. We also place churches on the ESS platform at each university so that incoming students find them.

EDUCATION

- **Christian High Schools** Help school counselors with special tools to prepare and connect students for the future as well as a dashboard to follow the progress of students during high school and on to college. We have partnerships with ACSI and all other main school associations. This documented measurable success that the school can demonstrate also helps with enrollment of parents.
- **Home Schooling Education – See ESS Homeschools** Equips homeschool parents with many of the college prep resources they would find with a school guidance counselor.

HIGH SCHOOL MINISTRIES

- **High School Youth Ministry** – ESS specifically partners with ministries serving Public high schools since this is the best training ground for ministry and college. Among other things help them preserve the investment they have made into high school students so that they carry their faith and learned evangelism practices into college. - **FCA Fellowship of Christian Athletes** – We are adding all their University Huddles to our system then the high school huddles into our current ESS High School groups that are available at every high school in America. COLLEGE MINISTRIES & UNIVERSITY CULTURE

- **College Ministry – See Every Student Sent College Ministry.** ESS serves all large and small college ministries. The 11 largest US college ministries have downloaded their data to us which has placed every student sent on nearly every US campus.
- **Impacting Secular University Culture** – ESS enables students to create missional communities in academic departments and other “corners” of the campus to add to students in that discipline, lead professors to Christ, and impact department culture. ESS also partners like InterVarsity Emerging Scholars to help them attract high school students to consider the vocation of college professor.
- **International missions and impact** – ESS partners include Intervarsity ISM, Cru International Students, ISI – International Students and others. More Christian college grads also = more sent students to the nations.

- **Christian Universities** – ESS helps Christian universities to attract students via missional communities on the ESS platform. This not only assists with enrollment, but let's incoming students connect with a more intentional group of Christian friends from the outset rather than having their first friends be students who are not really following Christ. This also helps tap the immense intellectual resources within these universities to impact the US educational system.

CAREER AND MAJOR

MARKETPLACE AND CULTURE

- **Transition to the Workplace** – ESS is expanding our system for the transition to the workplace so that college seniors can have already met marketplace people in their future city and have a guide to churches and accountability to impact their workplace. Currently over 1/3 of students in college ministries find themselves alone and succumb to the culture rather than influencing it.

- **Marketplace Ministry** – See link for ways we assist growing number of marketplace ministry partners.
- **Technology** – Students live in technology and many of them follow tech careers. One of our key partners in this area is [**Faith Tech**](#), where we have already started establishing social groups on various campuses where they have a presence.
- **Financial Advisors – Kingdom Advisors** ESS helps Christian financial advisors to serve their families more holistically in terms of what we call the three pillars of college success: Christian fellowship, selecting the best college major, and minimizing college debt. We also connect families in our network two Kingdom Advisors.
- **Christian Business Men CBMC** – And [Member Page](#) – Help CBMC Find new and younger membership. Provide a way for CBMC members to give back in terms of holding zoom meetings on particular business and market subjects with college students. Help solve the large national problem where college grads fall away increased when they are not connected in their new city.
